This often results in the bishop being traded, creating an imbalance of White's doubled pawns versus the two bishops advantage.

The French has a reputation for solidity and resilience, although some lines such as the Winawer Variation can lead to sharp complications. Black's position is often somewhat cramped in the early game; in particular, the pawn on e6 can impede the development of the bishop on c8.

Qg4, the most popular and critical line of the Winawer, while about half of the book dealt with 7. Nf3/a4, even though these two moves are played, in aggregate, about half as often as Qg4. Also, in my opinion, they don't generally lead to as tactical or complicated (or interesting) positions as 7. Qg4.

A common theme in the french defense is for black to aggressively attack the central pawns of white. It puts white on their back foot and gives black some very solid attacking lines. Play usually continues with 5.a3 attacking the bishop followed by 5...Bxc3 6.Nxc3 Nc6. Black should not try to hold onto the pawn with 6...f5 or 6...Nf6.

The French Defense is all the rage these days, and there are plenty of books examining the opening from Black's point of view. This book is a reaction from the other side. The "French Poisoned Pawn" 1. e4 e6 2. d2 d4 3. Nc3 Bb4 4. e5 c5 5. a3 Bxc3+ 6. bxc3 Ne7 7. Qg4 Qc7 8. Qxg7 Rg8 9. Qxh7 is an attempt to refute the Winawer French outright, not merely gain a slight positional advantage. The goal may be optimistic and the chess tournament battlefields are littered with the bodies of overambitious players of the White pieces, but the aggressive variation is more than capable of bringing home the point. The positions which arise are unclear and require a great deal of preparation. Although the first fifteen moves can be displayed with lightning speed, the middlegame often requires so much time as to plunge both players into serious time trouble. This opening is not for the faint of heart or short of time.

The Winawer variation of the French Defence is one of the most controversial openings in which Black launches a counterattack as early as move three. The strategically complex position that arise require delicate handling, making it the ideal choice for players who want to win with Black. Grandmasters who have played the Winawer's include Alexander Alekhine, Mikhail Botvinnik, Tigran Petrosian and Viktor Korchnoi.

Chess is sometimes seen as an abstract wargame; as a "mental martial art".

A chess opening or simply an opening refers to the initial moves of a chess game. The term can refer to the initial moves by either side, White or Black, but an opening by Black may also be known as a defense. There are dozens of different openings, and hundreds of variants. The Oxford Companion to Chess lists 1,327 named openings and variants. These vary widely in character from quiet positional play to wild tactical play. In addition to referring to specific move sequences, the opening is the first phase of a chess game, the other phases being the middlegame and the endgame.

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
